

FAQ:

- **What Is Tier Pricing?**

Tier Pricing may seem confusing but don't fear! We will explain it here and any further questions you have feel free to contact us!

There are three tiers in our pricing options. Tier One is a heavily donor funded discount price. What this means is that you pay less to send your child to camp and the rest of the cost is paid for through donations specifically designated for sending kids to camp. Tier Three reflects the actual cost of what it takes to send a child to camp and Tier Two is a combination of Tiers One and Three. It is still a discounted price but is closer to the actual cost than Tier One.

So choose which Tier you feel most comfortable with. And don't worry because payments as always are kept confidential and no matter which Tier you choose your child will get the same experience at camp as all the other children.

- **Withdrawal/Cancellation Policy:**

Timberlake will provide a full refund for fund paid, less the camper deposit (\$100 for Elementary, Jr High, Horsemanship, and Senior High, \$50 for Primary and SALT camps), if notified not later than 24 hrs prior to the day of camp. *Deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable. Starting on the first day of camp there is no refund for withdrawals

- **What to expect on the first day of camp.**

- Registration opens at 4 pm and ends at 5:00 pm. At registration your camper will:
 - Check-in
 - Deposit store money.
 - Turn in medications.
 - Receive campsite assignment.
- After your camper is registered you will head to their campsite to meet their cabin leader. We encourage parents to go along with their camper to meet the cabin leader, help them settle into the cabin, and meet their fellow cabin mates. Camp introduction and supper will officially kick off the week of camp and is held at the eating shelter @ 5:00 pm. (Parents are welcome to stay for through supper)

- **What to expect on the last day of camp.**

- Friday mornings, campers will get packed up and ready to head home. Our closing program begins at 10:30 am for all camps except horsemanship campers. The closing program for Horsemanship campers begins at 9:30 am and is held at the horse complex. We invite all parents to the closing program to experience fun and energetic recap of the week of camp.
- We take campers safety very seriously, as a result we require that campers are signed out by authorized adult.

- Camp Store refunds are given to the campers. Amounts are rounded to the nearest dollar.
- Camper medications will be available for pick-up by an authorized adult at the first aid station.

- **What should I pack?**

Clothes that can get dirty or wet (No strapless, spaghetti straps, or shirts that have large cut outs in them are allowed. No short shorts)

One piece swimsuit (If two piece swimsuit, camper will be expect to wear a t-shirt over their suit)

Tennis Shoes and/or Sandals (Shoes are required at all times unless in the cabin, shower or at swim time.)

Basic Bathroom Necessities (Toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap etc)

Towels (One for showering and one for the beach)

Sleeping Bag and Pillow

Water Bottle

Sunscreen

Bug Spray

Bible

Notebook

Pen or Pencils

Disposable Camera

Medications- to be turned into the First Aider

Store Money- to be turned in at Registration
